The four packages available are:

- 1) Combo-\$20-(typically includes a minimum of 4 assorted-meat items, 5 varieties of fresh vegetables and 2 fresh fruits)
- 2) Mini-Meat-\$11-(typically includes a minimum of 4 assorted frozen meat items)
- 3) Produce -\$10-(typically includes 5 varieties of fresh vegetables & 2 fresh fruits)
- 4) Mega Meat-\$25-(typically includes 7-9 assorted frozen meat items)
